Notes for Students

Week 5 (20/8 / 18 - 26/8/18)

Please Note: if you are from an Independent School the Fair is in your Week 5

- **T** Ensure you have a <u>Safety and Certification</u> form on the back of your project
- **T** Fill out <u>photo consent</u> form and give to your teacher
- Glue copies of Ethics approval or Use of Animals or Use of Microorganisms forms onto back of your project, as required
- **I** If you are unsure of the category for your project please check with your teacher
- Make sure you have entered your project on the <u>Digital Entry Form</u> confirm this with your teacher. (Due Monday 20th August)
- Check with your teacher about what props you can use on your project some substances likes plants and soils are prohibited inside the museum
 - If you are a senior student you may enter using the digital entry form or enter on Project Registration Day

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Wednesday 29 th	Project Registration Day	5:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.
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Either

- Make sure your teacher has your project to take in the evening -keep your log books and props to add to your project on judging day

Or

- Organise with your parents to bring you and your project to Epsom Girls Grammar between 5:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m. (see details of venue below) -keep your log books and props to add to your project on judging day
- Senior Students bring in your project and book a judging time for Friday
- Make sure your project has the following as they will be checked
 - Safety & Certification form attached and all parts complied with
 - -Ethics approval, if required (copy glued onto back of project)
 - -Use of <u>Animals</u> and Use of <u>Microorganism</u>s forms are in log books, as required (copy glued onto back of project)

Student Drop-Off For Judging

- You should be dropped off at the South Door of the Museum.
- No bags can be taken into the museum (you may bring your props in a plastic bag) Any parking in the area has time limits
- You may enter the museum through the Atrium Entrance (South Door) but you will not have access to the display area until the appropriate time - Year 9 & 10 can enter from 8:30 a.m. and Year 7 & 8 entry will start at 10:30 a.m.

Judging

- Wait in the area assigned until all competitors arrive
- Listen to instructions from the Chief Judge
- When instructed move to your project add any props and your log book now
- Be prepared to discuss and 'sell' your project to the judges
- Once judged returned to assigned area and wait for a call back or further instructions before leaving
- Bring a book, cards etc to keep yourself occupied while waiting
- You may not bring any bags into the museum
- You may not leave the event space until you are instructed
- When leaving take any valuable props from your project with you.

If you are a senior student

-] come at the time you booked during set up
- wear the identification provided at registration and show this to security to gain access to your project
- discuss with the judges your purpose and findings, make sure you let them know all about your work
- **]** check if any others judges may wish to see you
- leave the venue when your judging is complete
