Week 3 - 5

(4/8/25 - 24/8/25)

- **♣** All Students:
- ♣ Ensure you have a Safety and Certification form on the back of your project
- Fill out the <u>photo consent</u> form, have it signed by your parents and give it to your teacher. Or your parents can send a confirmation email to your teacher.
- ♣ Glue copies of ethics approval or 'Use of Animals' or 'Use of Microorganisms' forms onto the back of your project, as required (Place originals in Log Book)
- If you are unsure of the category for your project please check with your teacher
- ♣ Make sure you have entered your project on the <u>Digital Entry Form</u> confirm this with your teacher. (Due Monday 11th August)
- ♣ Produce a PDF version of your project. Check with your teacher for the correct naming of your PDF file and how to share it. This <u>information is also here</u>.
 - A PDF copy must be uploaded by Monday 25th August.
 - Just click the link then drag and drop the files onto the page.
 - Confirm with your teacher if you are to do this or they will do it for you.

Y12 and Y13 Students

- Enter using the <u>digital entry form</u> as above. Your project does not have to be completed when you enter it but we have to know it is being entered by the due date.
- You will need to **book a time for the judging of your project**! Do this via <u>our online booking page!</u>
- Please place a correctly named PDF copy of your project into the drop box as soon as possible. All the <u>information on that is here.</u>

-you can take your \log books and props to add to your project when you set it up

- Senior Students (Y12-13 only) bring in your project. Check that you have booked a judging time for Friday via <u>our online booking page!</u> One booking per project.
- Make sure your project has the following as they will be checked
 - Safety & Certification form attached and all parts complied with
 - -Ethics approval, if required (copy glued onto back of project)
 - -Use of <u>Animals</u> and Use of <u>Microorganisms</u> forms are in log books, as required (copy glued onto the back of project)



Friday 29th August Judging Day

- Year 9, 10, & 11 students should arrive **by** 8:45 a.m. and will leave from 10:00 a.m.
- $\stackrel{\bullet}{+}$ Year 7 & 8 students should arrive **by** 10:45 a.m. and will leave at 12:30 p.m.
- + Year 12 & 13 students will be booking their own times throughout the day.

Judging Y7, 8, 9, 10, 11

- Wait in the area assigned until all competitors arrive. Food can only be eaten outside the hall, eg. foyer.
- ♣ Listen to instructions from the Chief Judge
- When instructed move to your project add any props and your log book if you have not done so already
- Be prepared to discuss and 'sell' your project to the judges
- Once judged, return to the assigned area and wait for a call back or further instructions before leaving
- ♣ Viewing of other projects is only during public viewing times!
- Bring a book, cards etc. to keep yourself occupied while waiting
- ♣ You may not bring any bags into judging area. They should be left in the assigned waiting area
- When leaving, take any valuable props from your project with you.

Judging Y12, 13

- Come at the <u>time you booked on the booking form</u>. Enter the venue and stand by your project.
- lacktriangle Make yourself known to a committee member when you arrive
- Discuss with the judges your purpose and findings, make sure you let them know all about your work
- ♣ Check with the Lead Senior Judge if any others judges may wish to see you
- ♣ Leave the venue when your judging is complete

Public Viewing

Friday 29th Viewing Evening 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.

Saturday 30th Viewing Day 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

- ♣ The Venue will be open to the public but importantly to you, your families and friends
- ♣ Projects which have been awarded a placing will have a certificate attached while those with Special prizes will be indicated with a sticker. All place winners and special prize winning projects will be taken to the Prize Giving by the Fair Committee.
- ♣ All 1st, 2nd and 3rd placings and an indication of any Special Prizes will also be posted on the Fair website <u>scifair.org.nz</u>. This may take a day or two to appear. Follow our Facebook page for updates.

Saturday 30th Pack Up 4.00 p.m. (no earlier) to 5:00 p.m.

Project Pick Up

- ♣ all placed and special prize-winning projects will remain at the venue to be taken to prize giving, so they do not need to be picked up but all **props and log books** will need to be removed on Saturday
- ♣ all other projects need to be picked up between 4:00 p.m. and 5:00 p.m.
- ♣ no projects will be allowed to leave before 4:00 p.m.
- ♣ if you cannot be there to pick up your project make arrangements with another student
 or your teacher to have it picked up for you
